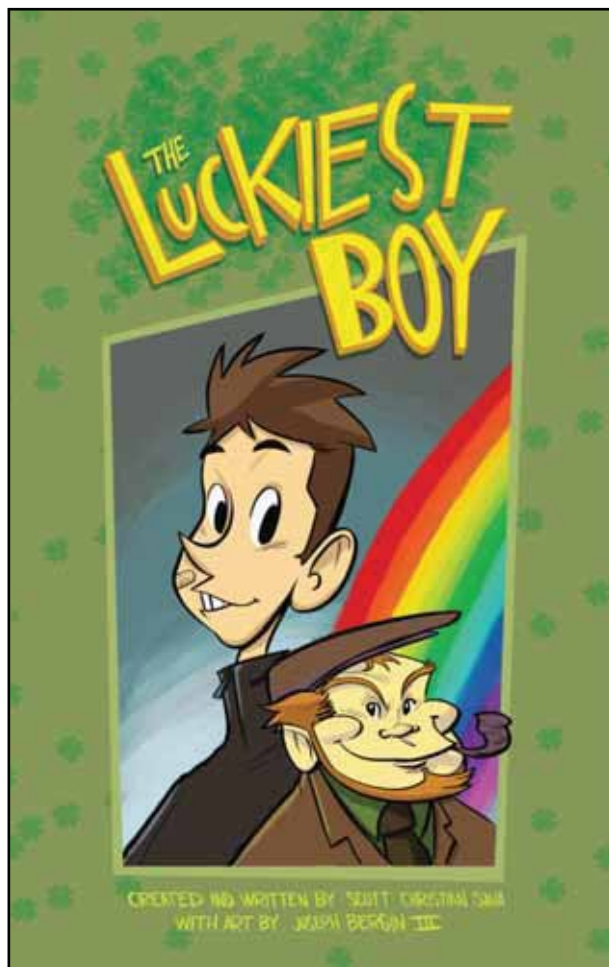

THE LUCKIEST BOY



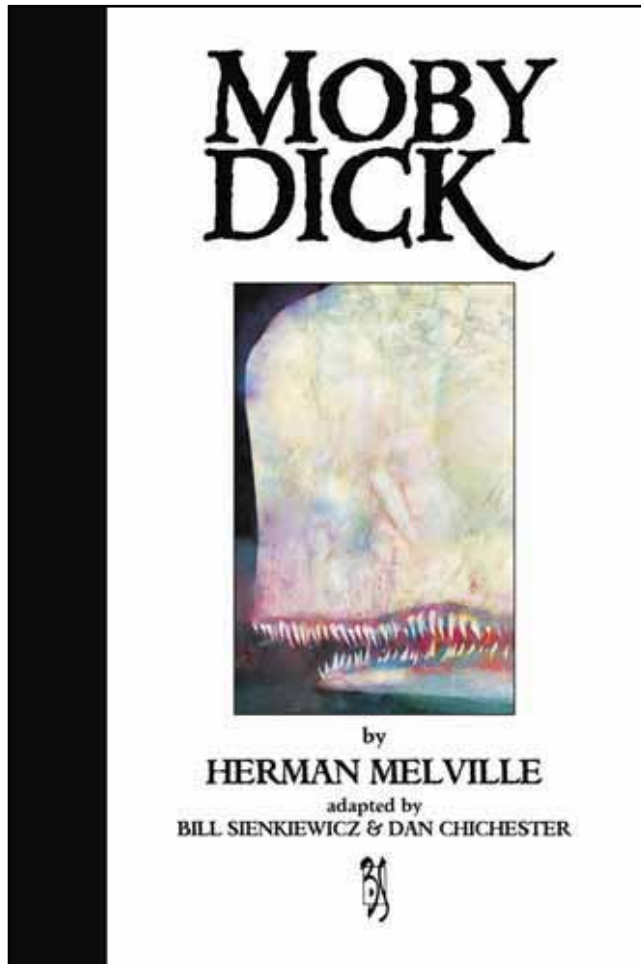
